# Phone Photos Anyone?

## Sharp's Leica-Branded Aquos R6 Phone Packs a Massive 1-Inch Sensor



[Sharp](#) has just announced the [Aquos R6](#) smartphone with a large Leica-branded lens and huge 1-inch sensor, a first for a traditional handset manufacturer.

[The Verge](#) reports that the Sharp Aquos R6 has a “Summicron” lens that is produced by Leica and a large 20-megapixel, 1-inch sensor. While it is not the first phone ever to feature a sensor this large — the [Lumix CM1](#) carries that honor — it is the first by a traditional handset manufacturer to do so and may have a sensor that was [actually designed specifically for a smartphone](#).

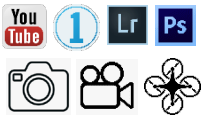

## Street Photography

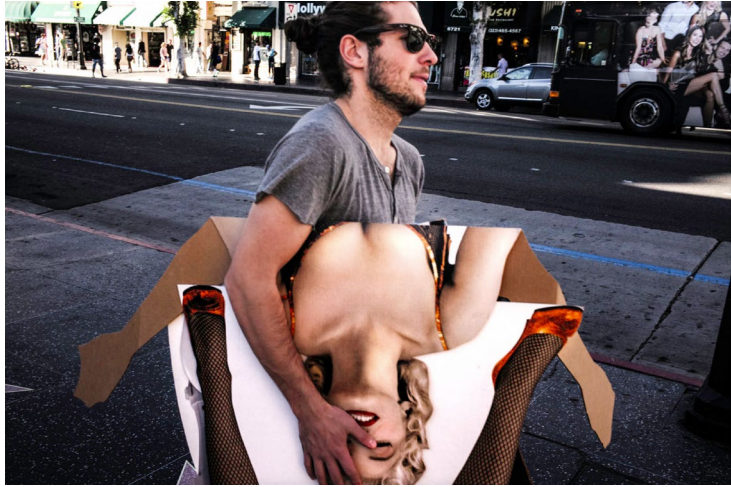
- Experiment and explore

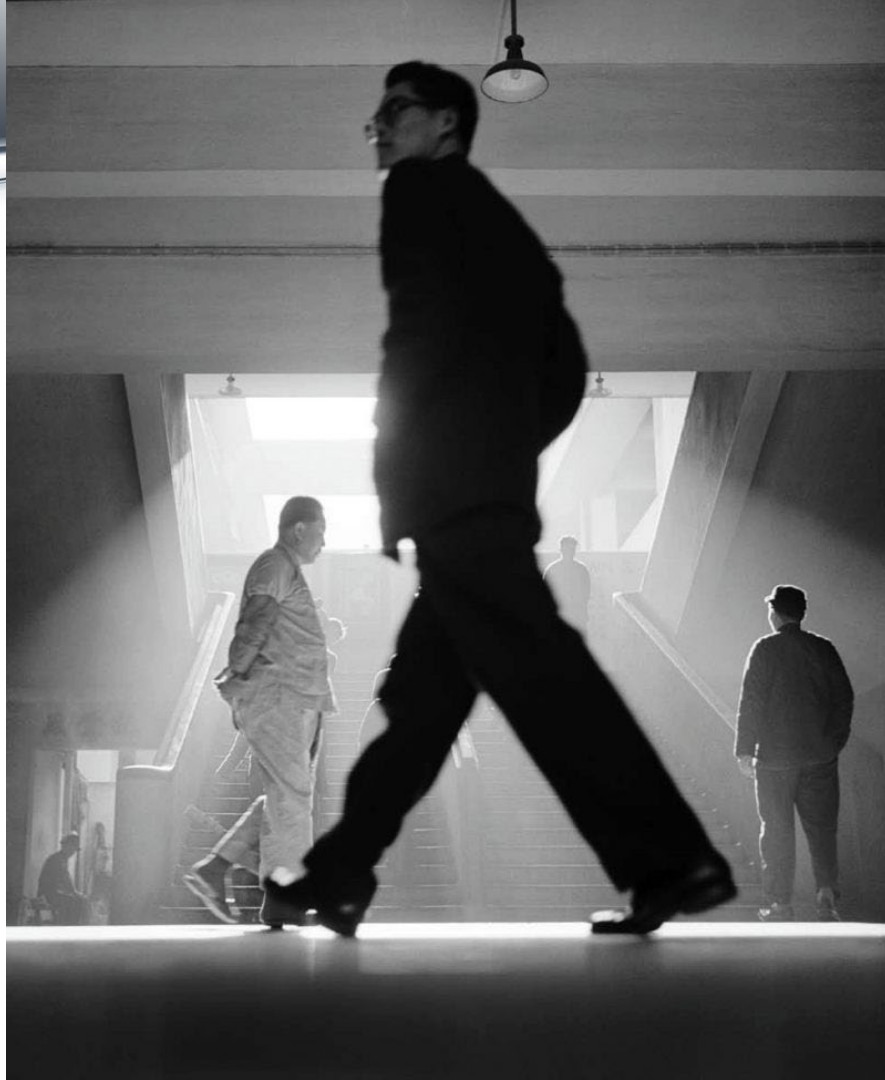

Joaquín Gómez Sastre | Spain

→ **Image title:** Rapa das bestas

→ **Image description:** Some *aloitadores* jump on a wild horse and only with their hands and bodies try to reduce it to be able to cut its manes and deworm it. Every year in the Galician town of Sabucedo (Spain) they repeat this tradition with the wild horses that have been in winter in the mountains.





TOP 10

Azim Khan Ronnie | Bangladesh

→ **Image title:** Incense workers

→ **Image description:** Vietnamese workers sits surrounded by thousands of incense sticks in Quang Phu Cau, a village in Hanoi, Vietnam, where these sticks have been traditionally made for hundreds of years. Incense plays an important role in the spiritual lives of Vietnamese people. People use incense in all worship activities. The bamboo bundles are arranged on the ground on sunny days so as to dry them. To make the incense sticks the bamboo is first split in two, cleaned and dusted and then a third of the stick.

TOP 10

Azim Khan Ronnie | Bangladesh

→ **Image title:** Praying with fire

→ **Image description:** Devotees attend prayer with burning incense and light oil lamps before break fasting during a religious festival called Rakher Upobash or Kartik Brati in Narayanganj, Bangladesh. Bengali people of the Hindu faith in Bangladesh sit in prayer celebrating the 18th century Hindu Saint Baba Lokenath with a 'Rakher Upobas' prayer and fast day Every year thousands of Hindu devotees gather in front of Shri Shri Lokenath Brahmachari Ashram temple for the Kartik Brati or Rakher Upobash religious festival.

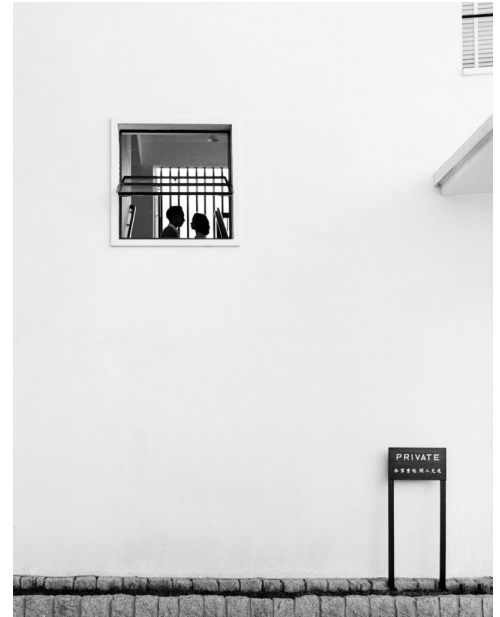
# Street Photography Ideas

- Gear
  - Less is more!
  - Avoid changing lenses
    - Zoom x Fixed lens
    - Keep one lens for a minimum time
  - Big equipment = more attention



# Street Photography Ideas

- Not Perfect
  - Looking for perfection we lose the moment
- Simplicity
  - Busy city background -> less is more
  - Monochromatic
  - Select what to include in the frame



# Street Photography Ideas

- Settings
  - Think too much? GONE
  - If in doubt: f/8 with Aperture Priority
    - After you get comfortable, play with the settings
    - High ISO = OK
    - Low Shutter Speed = Risky

- Composition Techniques that may help
  - Leading lines
  - Frames
  - Colors
  - Tell a story
